PROGRAMS

Crisis Hotline

The BAWC crisis hotline is staffed 24/7 to meet the needs of survivors. Your support ensures survivors have a place to turn for support and safety.

Counseling

Trained and licensed therapists provide trauma-informed counseling to survivors, free-ofcharge. Your support helps over 400 individuals annually receive the support they need.

Advocacy & Transportation

Survivors have varied needs and often face barriers to living life after trauma. Supporting advocacy and transportation helps survivors meet their basic needs, secure employment, and so much more.

Shelter & Safety

Individuals in immediate danger can find safety in our shelter with their children and pets. Your support provides a safe bedroom to over 300 individuals annually.

Forensic Exams

A team of highly trained nurses, therapists, and advocates respond to the immediate health and safety needs of survivors. Forensic exams are provided to collect evidence for prosecution.

Basic Needs & Food Support

BAWC provides all shelter residents with food for three meals a day as well as personal care items. Non-residential clients also receive support as needed. With your support, survivors can meet all their basic needs and focus on healing.
